



RECOMMENDED KITTEN STARTER PACK

A familiar start at home

To help your kitten feel comfortable and maintain a familiar routine after going home, we recommend purchasing the following items before pickup. These are products our kittens already know and enjoy.

| Food Essentials

Weruva Kitten Can Jam! Wet Food

[Weruva Kitten Can Jam! Variety Pack - 12 x 3 oz cans](#)

This is the primary wet food we feed our kittens. The variety pack contains several flavors and textures, so your kitten may prefer certain varieties over others.

We recommend having at least one to two cases available before your kitten arrives.

Royal Canin Mother & Babycat Dry Kibble

Our kittens are raised eating Royal Canin Mother & Babycat kibble. It is formulated for mothers and kittens from approximately one to four months old and has very small pieces that are easy for young kittens to eat.

Please continue feeding this food initially, even if you plan to change your kitten's diet. Keeping their food consistent during the transition into a new home can help reduce unnecessary digestive upset.

| Feeding Upgrade We Recommend

Viva Raw Complete Cat Food

For families interested in transitioning to a fresh raw diet, we highly recommend researching Viva Raw Complete for Cats. A moisture-rich, properly balanced fresh diet may support hydration, healthy body condition and a soft, beautiful coat.

Viva Raw is shipped frozen and is not normally purchased through Amazon. Introduce any new food gradually rather than changing your kitten's entire diet immediately. Follow Viva Raw's storage, handling and transition instructions, and discuss raw feeding with your veterinarian - especially for young kittens or immunocompromised people or pets in the household.

| Water and Hydration

Clear Cat Water Fountain

We recommend a fountain with a transparent reservoir or viewing window. This makes it much easier to see how much water your kitten is drinking and when the fountain needs to be refilled.

Look for:

- A clear reservoir or large front viewing window
- A quiet, replaceable pump
- Easily available replacement filters
- A design that can be completely disassembled and cleaned
- A stainless-steel drinking surface, when possible

Purchase at least one package of replacement filters when ordering the fountain.

| Scratching and Lounging

Oval Cardboard Scratcher Bed

Our kittens love the oval, bowl-shaped cardboard scratchers. They serve as both a scratching surface and a comfortable lounging bed.

We recommend placing one in the kitten's main adjustment room and another in the primary family living area. Providing attractive scratching surfaces from the beginning can help redirect scratching away from furniture.

| Favorite Toy

Yeowww! Catnip Stinkies Fish

[Yeowww! Stinkies Catnip Sardines - 3-pack](#)

These small catnip-filled fish are one of our kittens' favorite toys. The product is commonly called Yeowww! Catnip Stinkies.

Catnip does not affect every young kitten immediately, so some kittens may become more interested in these toys as they get older.

| Tidy Cats Clumping Litter

We recommend a gentle, unscented clumping litter such as Tidy Cats for easy cleanup and effective odor control.

Start with a shallow layer of litter in the box and keep it clean daily to encourage consistent litter box use.

| Litter Box Setup

Low-Edge Kitten Litter Box

A low-edge litter box is essential for young kittens, making it easy for them to enter and exit comfortably while they are still small and developing coordination.

Look for:

- Low entry height for easy access
- Simple, open design for quick training
- Easy-to-clean plastic material
- Wide enough space for turning and digging

| Grooming Essentials

Nail Clippers and Grooming Tools

Regular grooming helps your kitten stay comfortable, clean, and well-adjusted to handling from an early age. We recommend having a small grooming kit ready before your kitten arrives.

Recommended items:

Cat nail clippers (scissor-style or guillotine style designed for small cats)

Soft slicker brush for gentle coat maintenance

[Swihauk Self-Cleaning Slicker Brush](#)

Stainless steel grooming comb for detangling and checking the coat

Unscented grooming wipes for quick cleanups between baths

[G.A.S Lick-Safe Unscented Pet Wipes - 200-count](#)

Start nail trimming early and keep sessions short and positive. Most kittens adjust quickly when grooming is introduced as a normal, calm routine.

READY FOR HOME

Starter-Pack Checklist

Before bringing your kitten home, we recommend having:

- ☐ One to two cases of Weruva Kitten Can Jam wet food
- ☐ One bag of Royal Canin Mother & Babycat kibble
- ☐ One transparent water fountain
- ☐ One package of replacement fountain filters
- ☐ Two oval cardboard scratcher beds
- ☐ One package of Yeowww! Catnip Stinkies
- ☐ Cat nail clippers
- ☐ Soft slicker brush
- ☐ Stainless steel grooming comb
- ☐ Unscented grooming wipes
- ☐ Shallow food dishes or stainless-steel plates
- ☐ A food-storage container for the dry kibble
- ☐ Unscented clumping litter
- ☐ A low edge litter box

Please avoid making sudden food changes during your kitten's first days at home. Moving into a new environment is already a significant adjustment, and maintaining a familiar diet can help make the transition easier. Once you have added these essentials to your home, you will be ready to receive your kitten. We are so excited for you to bring home your new fluffy addition!
